

In fact, it has only been in the last few years that I have even started sharing it when some one asks. Doreen is not one of those common place names. And then just this morning as I was researching the importance of names in the Bible I came across a commentary that said the name Doreen along with Dorothy, Mattea, Thea and Theodora all mean "gift of God." What an awesome thought that brides might be wearing a wedding gown carrying that name: "Gift of God Design", after all every bride is a gift of God made perfectly in His design.

In the Bible names are rich in symbolism. Some signify origin, some denote purpose. Adam is most likely a form of the Hebrew word for "ground." Eve means "living" and according to Genesis 3:20 her role was to be "the mother of all the living." You might remember that Jesus changed Simon's name to Peter which has the meaning rock. Matthew 16:18 tells us that Jesus declared that he would build his church on the one named Peter. But did you know that Simon means "that hears or obeys." Christ would not have been able to build the church upon the one he named rhe rock if he had not first heard the call of Christ and obeyed. Jesus' own name means Savior and Deliverer."

Our enrollment this year will be 61 which is more than we typically have. Logistics will be tricky, to say the least, but we will teach the Word of God to seven more children than in past years. Misty and I have held staff training August 22-26 and we are now prepared to teach.

Meet the Teacher will be September 1 at 6:00pm followed by the first day on September 6. We are ready to teach not for our glory but for the glory of God. Please be in prayer for the staff, children, and families as we minster to our littles.


