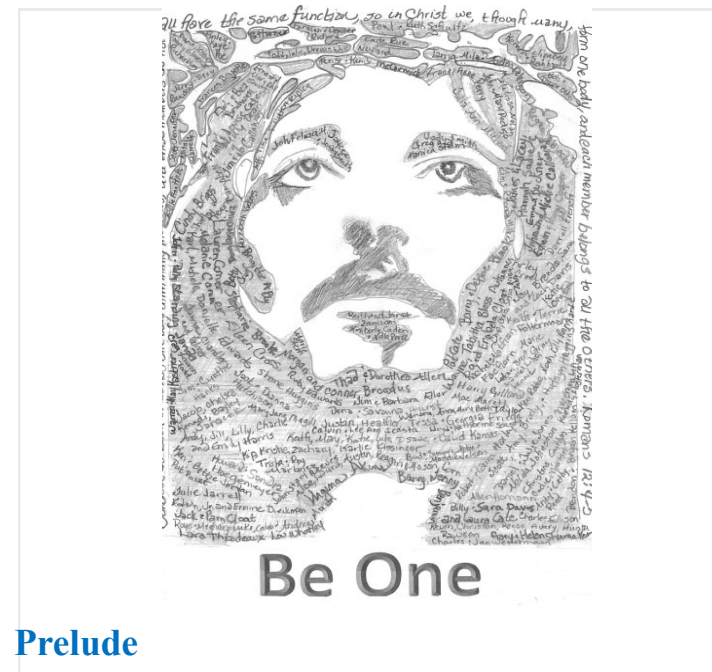

Second Scripture Matthew 22:34-36

Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together.
