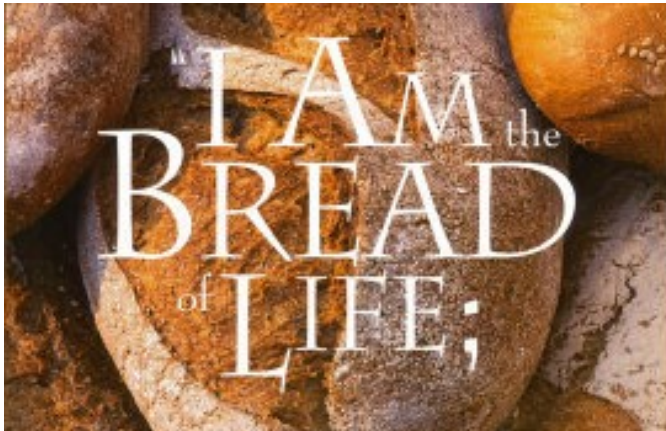

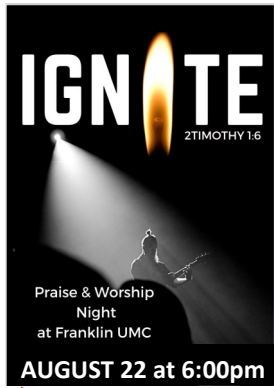
Now let us remind ourselves of what we believe as we head out into the world.
