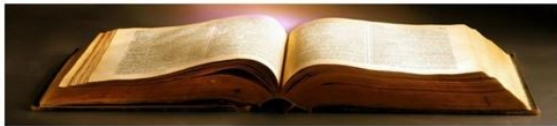
Apostles' Creed

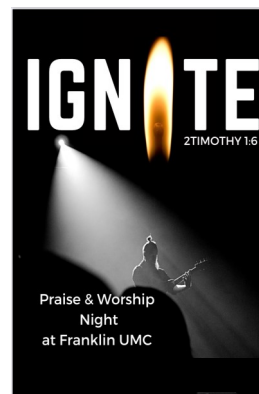
