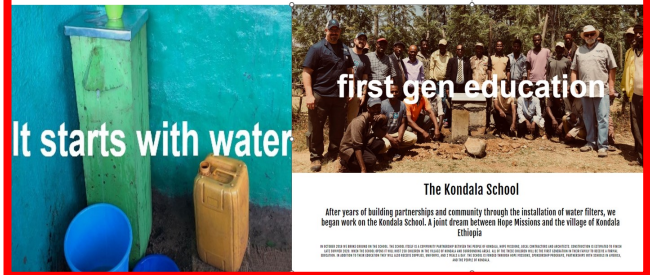
To be part of the Dream.
