

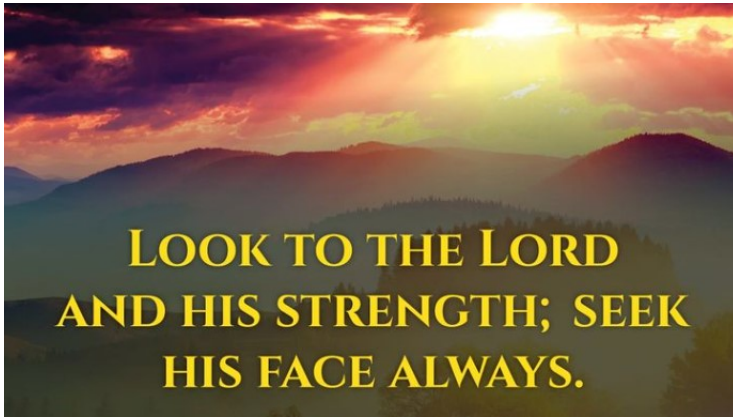

Prayer and Scripture Robbie Reinhardt Psalm 105:1-11; 43-45
